APPLICATION

Basic educational requirements for entry to a higher vocational education. Specific requirements: English 6, Swedish 2, Mathematics 1b or equivalent. At least two years work experience in a service or tourism related position, (minimum 75% of a full time position). The work experience must have been carried out after a completed upper secondary school education.

All applicants who are eligible for the program will be called to complete two written tests and one oral test. The results of these tests will also be included in the application process.

The program is publicly funded and students are entitled to Government student loans.
